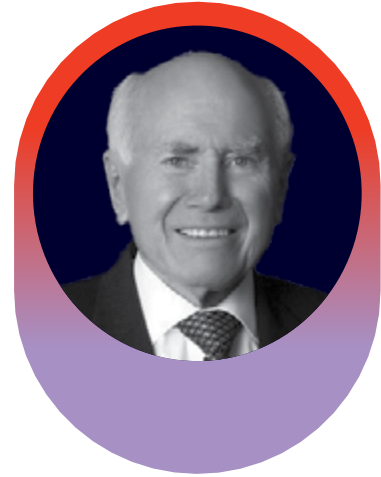
Ride the Wave

In May 2023, the CFO Forum will uncover opportunities, insights and strategies for you to surf the waves of change and land on the shores of success.



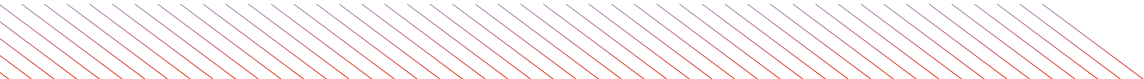
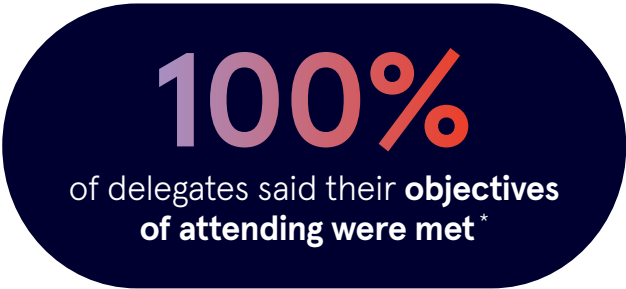
The Hon John Howard OM AC returns for the 2023 CFO Forum

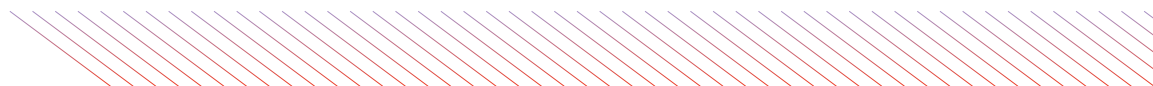

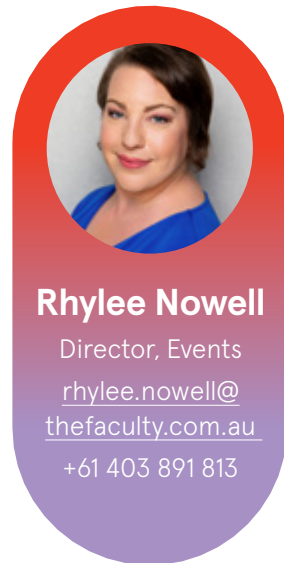

Who will win?

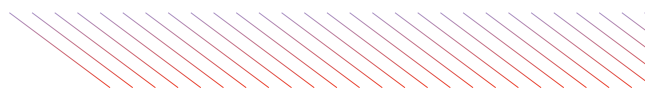
